- Applying for an original Social Security card (under the age of 12)

For Children Age 17 and Under applying for an initial or replacement SSN card:

 - DO NOT sign or date the application form until a Passport Agent is present and has reviewed it
- Copy of Child's Current Valid Passport (tourist and no fee)
- Copy of Child's Consular Report of Birth Certificate

- Copy of Signing Parent's Photo ID (front and back of military ID)
- (1) One special delivery envelope (A4 size) with prepaid postage up to 500g from the British post office.
